## Mini Mission What to Bring To Camp

## Greetings Mini Mission Campers and Workers!

We are so excited you chose to join us for our 10th Helping Hands Mission Camp. Below are some things you may want to bring with you to ensure an awesome experience:

- Bible
- Pillow(s), blankets for rest time
- Any medications you need to take during the week with instructions on time, dosage, etc. These will be kept locked up for safety and given when it is time.
- A change of clothes to include underwear and a plastic bag with your name on it. A towel for after water games.
- Small backpack or drawstring bag to carry items with you when you leave the church
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent
- Hat with a brim to shade your head and face
- Work Gloves
- A water bottle with your name on it
- Work clothing:
  - Only t-shirts on work site. No tank tops, spaghetti straps or camis. T-shirts with the sleeves cut off are okay.
  - No sagging pants that need to be pulled up, you will need your hands for working. This
    clothing WILL get dirty with paint as well as grease, dirt, etc. *Please don't work in your*nice clothes.
  - o \*\*COVER TOED SHOES to work in; this is REQUIREMENT for safety
- Play clothing:
  - Please dress for OUTDOOR play. It will be hot and we will have water activities. Please
    consider that you are representing a church youth group and dress appropriately: no
    spaghetti straps, short shorts (when arms are down by your sides, the shorts must not be
    shorter than your longest finger), low hanging pants, inappropriate language on shirts, etc.
- Swimsuit: *one piece* is REQUIRED, you WILL NOT be allowed to participate in water fun if you ignore this rule. No bikinis or tankinis. This rule applies to EVERYONE regardless of age.

We have a **NO ELECTRONICS** Rule in Mini Camp. You may bring movies to share during rest time . You may also bring music to share. Please remember that this is a church retreat when making your selection.

If you bring music, please make it Christian, inappropriate music will be confiscated and returned at the end of the week.

This is going to be an awesome experience for everyone involved. Let's all come prepared to watch what God makes possible this week.
