

Rules for Helping Hands Mission Camp

The following rules are meant to keep us all safe and to focus our minds on Jesus during the week of camp:

- ☑ Please remember - - this building is a house of worship and should be treated with the utmost respect for the building and property in and around it
- ☑ No running, throwing things, or horseplay in the building. Be careful of windows and glass doors
- ☑ Do not sit on sanctuary chairs/pews until you have cleaned up from the worksite
- ☑ **SANTUARY IS OFF LIMITS EXCEPT DURING WORSHIP TIME**
- ☑ **KITCHEN IS OFF LIMITS TO CAMPERS**
- ☑ **CLEAN UP DUTY** – The church must be cleaned during the week and each team will be assigned a daily task.
- ☑ No one can leave the building after Lights Out. If you have an emergency, talk to your dorm monitor
- ☑ **NO FOOD IN DORM ROOMS**
- ☑ There will be no water fights or any other pranks inside the building
- ☑ Weapons, drugs, alcohol, and tobacco are prohibited
- ☑ No clothing that will show your midriff, has spaghetti straps, low cut or inappropriate content on them – if you are seen wearing clothes deemed inappropriate, you will be told to change your clothes
- ☑ Shorts or skirts must be longer than longest finger when arms are down at your side. Pants should not be sagging or showing underwear
- ☑ **NO SWIMSUITS** – Bring an old t-shirt and shorts for water games
- ☑ Bring appropriate clothing for worksites: Shorts/Pants no shorter than your knee, t-shirt and shoes with closed toe. **NO FLIP FLOPS ON WORKSITES**
- ☑ **SAFETY ON WORKSITES IS TOP PRIORITY. NO HORSEPLAY OR WASTING OF SUPPLIES WILL BE TOLERATED.**
- ☑ **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR WORKSITE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF SITE LEADER, SITE ASSISTANT OR TEAM MANAGER**
- ☑ **POWER TOOLS MAY NOT BE USED BY CAMPERS UNDER 18 WITHOUT DIRECT ADULT SUPERVISION**

- STAY OUT OF DORMS THAT ARE NOT YOURS – NO BOYS ON GIRLS HALL AND NO GIRLS ON BOYS HALL – OPPOSITE SEXES MAY VISIT DURING MEALS, WORSHIP, AND GAME TIME**
- CAMPERS SHOULD NOT BE IN AN AREA UNSUPERVISED BY ADULTS**
- PDA**s (public displays of affection) between campers should be appropriate to a CHURCH retreat: no lap sitting, hugging, kissing, hand holding, snuggling, etc.
- MEAL TIME:** Please find a seat until prayers are said. If a camper volunteers to pray over the meal, they will be allowed to get their food when the adults do.
- MEAL TIME: TEAMS WILL BE CALLED TO LINE UP FOR MEALS**
- NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES ALLOWED AT CAMP – THIS INCLUDES (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) CELL PHONES, IPODS, IPADS, VIDEO GAMES OR SYSTEMS, MP3 PLAYERS, TABLETS, ETC.**
 - Camp is designed to help campers unplug and focus on Jesus and serving others

When Camp is Over:

- THE BUILDING MUST BE CLEANED AND PUT BACK TOGETHER – TEAMS WILL ASSIGNED A TASK ON FRIDAY**
- ALL COOLERS AND TOOLS MUST BE RETURNED**

If you have an emergency and need to leave camp for any reason, you MUST let Stephanie Jenkins know.
